

# Singapore Bowling Mixed Doubles Baker Challenge 2017 Date: 8 & 9 July 2017

Venue: SingaporeBowling @ Rifle Range

Rules & Regulations, Prize List and Entry Form

#### 1. NAME

This Challenge shall be known as the Singapore Bowling Mixed Doubles Baker Challenge 2017.

#### 2. OBJECTIVE

The purpose is to promote bowling among secondary, tertiary and university schools, besides fostering and maintaining the spirit of good fellowship and true sportsmanship among students.

#### 3. MEMBERSHIP AND ELIGIBILITY

This Challenge is open to all Singapore citizens, permanent residents and foreign students studying in the <u>SECONDARY</u>, <u>TERTIARY and UNIVERSITY LEVEL</u>, each of which must individually and collectively qualify under the constitution, rules and regulation of Singapore Bowling Federation. <u>All participants are to be members of Clubs affiliated to the Singapore Bowling Federation and whose membership is current for the duration of the Challenge.</u>

It is the bowler's responsibility to check the status of qualification.

#### 4. FORMAT OF PLAY

This is a doubles mixed event, comprising of a Qualifying Round and Championship Round. Teams shall consist of two (2) members, one male and one female.

#### 5. QUALIFYING ROUND:

All teams will bowl 6-games series of Baker-format bowling.

#### 6. CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND:

#### Format: Knockout

The field will be cut to the Top 16 teams based on total pinfalls in the Qualifying Round. The Top 16 teams will be seeded based on Qualifying Round standings and will bowl best 3 of 5 games Baker matches elimination to determine the Top 4. The top 4 team will bowl a single elimination to determine the tournament champion. Please see bowling schedule.

#### 7. TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

In the event of a tie in the qualifying round, the team with the highest high game series over the 6 game series shall win the tiebreaker. If this stills ends in a tie, the next high game will be used and this will continue until the tie is broken. In the event of a tie in the championship round, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off shall be used, and/or repeated until tie is broken.

#### 8. INTERRUPTED GAME

The Tournament-in-charge may authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the starting lanes would delay the normal progress of the game.

# 9. BOWLING ON WRONG LANES / WRONG SEQUENCE

When the lead-off bowler bowls on the wrong lane or bowl with the wrong sequence and the errors discovered before another bowler has bowled, a dead ball is declared and the bowler will be required to re-bowl on the correct lane.

#### 10. FEES

The entry fee is \$200/- per team of 2.

#### 11. ORDER OF BOWLING

After a game has started, no changes shall be made in the order of play during such series. Eg. Male bowler bowl first from the start of the series, he will be bowling first throughout the competition.

#### 12. SLOW BOWLING

Slow bowling is not allowed and bowlers must bowl when it is their turn to do so.

#### 13. REGISTRATION OF BOWLING BALL

It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling calls used are verified for correctness of weight and other specifications, conforming to World Bowling Playing Rules.

#### 14. DRESS CODE

Bowlers are required to be properly and appropriately dressed for bowling. Bowlers in the same team are required to wear the same attire color and design.

#### 15. DISABILITY, INJURY OR EMERGENCY

When a player is unable to complete a game because of disability, injury or emergency, the team of which he / she is a member of, shall count his / her actual score from the frames bowled in the game or blind score, whichever is higher will apply.

#### 16. OBVIOUS ERRORS

Errors in scoring or errors in calculation must be corrected by a responsible Tournament official immediately upon discovery of such errors. Questionable errors shall be decided by the Technical Committee.

#### 17. PROTESTS

Any protests affecting eligibility of general playing rules must be confirmed in writing not later than **twenty-four (24) hours** after the series in which the infraction occurred has been bowled. Any protests resulting out of competition on the concluding day of schedule must be filled immediately thereafter.

Each protest under this rule must be specific in itself and this rule shall not be construed to cover a previous or similar violation.
