Selection for the 30th SEA Games 2018

1. The Event

- 1.1 The 30th SEA Games (SEAG) will be held from 30th November to 10th December 2019 in Clark, Philippines.
- 1.2 The events which will be contested in the SEAG have been confirmed by the SEAG 2019 Organizing Committee as follow:

2. Selection Panel

- 2.1 Singapore Bowling Federation (SBF)'s National Coaching Staff will evaluate and recommend the athletes to SBF's Selection Sub-Committee for endorsement.
- 2.2 The Selection Sub-Committee comprises of:

 - c) Mrs Florence Khemlani
 - d) Mr William Wong
- 2.3 The recommended athletes will then be submitted to SBF's General Council for approval for nomination to SNOC to represent Singapore at the SEAG.

3. Appeals

3.1 The Appeals Sub-Committee is available to look into disputes relating to the selection or non-selection of an athlete.

4. General Eligibility

4.1 To be eligible for nomination each athlete must;

- (a) Be a citizen of the Republic of Singapore
- (b) Agree and sign the SBF's Code of Conduct/Bowler Agreement
- (c) Be able to commit to a regular training program outlined by the coaches at the beginning of the year

5. Selection Criteria

5.1 SBF's Nine (9) Selection Criteria:

- 1) Ability of athlete to listen to instruction
- 2) Team-first attitude
- 3) Assessed ability to handle pressure in Official Championships
- 4) Match-up to expected tournament lane and format conditions
- 5) Form in training and competitions
- 6) Adaptability
- 7) Personal discipline
- 8) Assessed ability to handle pressure in other Championships
- 9) Individual's potential to reach the world standard

5.2 The following information will be provided to support the selection of athletes:

- a) Coaches' overall assessment
- b) Results in Local / Overseas Competitions:

Women's Team

- i) Brunswick Euro Challenge
- ii) Thailand International Open
- iii) Malaysia International Open
- iv) Philippines International Open
- v) Hong Kong International Open
- vi) PWBA Tour
- vii) USBC Queens
- viii) 51st Singapore International Open

Men's Team

- i) H.H Emir Cup
- ii) DIBC Open Bowling Tournament
- iii) Thailand International Open
- iv) Malaysia International Open
- v) Philippine International Open
- vi) 51st Singapore International Open

- c) Performance data (e.g. Roll-off, Specto System Statistics, Competition Observation Players' Statistics [COPS])
- d) Training attendance
- e) Sports Medicine and Sports Science services update

6. Final Selection

- 6.1 Athlete must fulfil the requirements in clause 4 and will be selected based on selection criteria stated in clause 5.
- 6.3 Athletes shall be required to be certified medically fit to compete at the SEAG by qualified SSI personnel prior to nomination to the SNOC and shall remain medically fit to compete to be eligible to compete in the SEAG.
- 6.4 If a nominated athlete fails to fulfil the requirements stated in clause 4 and/or because of injury/illness is unable to represent Singapore at the SEAG, the selection panel, at its own discretion, reserves the sole right to replace the nominated athlete with another athlete. Replacement athletes must also fulfil the requirements in clause 4.
