## **Selection for the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games 2021**

### **1. The Event**

The 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games (SEAG) will be held from 21<sup>st</sup> November to 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2021 in Hanoi, Vietnam.

1.1 The events which will be contested in the SEAG have been confirmed by the SEAG 2021 Organizing Committee as follow:

### **2. Selection Panel**

2.1 Singapore Bowling Federation (SBF)'s National Coaching Staff will evaluate and recommend the athletes to SBF's Selection Sub-Committee for endorsement.

2.2 The Selection Sub-Committee comprises of:

- a) Mrs Jessie Phua (Chairman)
- b) Dr Valerie Teo
- c) Mr Tan Zhi Qiang
- d) Mr Delane Lim

2.3 The recommended athletes will then be submitted to SBF's General Council for approval for nomination to SNOC to represent Singapore at the SEAG.

### 3. Appeals

3.1 The Appeals Sub-Committee is available to look into disputes relating to the selection or non-selection of an athlete.

3.2 The Appeals Sub-Committee comprises:

- a) Mr William Wong (Chairman)
- b) Ms Grace Young-Diao
- c) Mr Wong Soon Hwa

10.2 In the event where a bowler does not agree with the results of the team selection, the bowler must write in to the Appeals Sub-Committee **strictly within seven (7) days** after official team announcement is made/ informed to the players via email. **Appeals made after the seven (7) will not be entertained.**

### 4. General Eligibility

4.1 To be eligible for nomination each athlete must;

(a) Be a citizen of the Republic of Singapore (Athletes must be Singapore Citizens, and should not be holding dual citizenship if they are above 21 years old, at the time of nomination.)

(b) Agree and sign the SBF's Code of Conduct/Bowler Agreement

(c) Be able to commit to a regular training program outlined by the coaches at the beginning of the year

## **5. Selection Criteria**

### 5.1 SBF's Nine (9) Selection Criteria:

- 1) Performance Under Pressure in Official Championships
- 2) Coachability
- 3) Technical Skills
- 4) Match Up & Adaptability
- 5) Team Synergy
- 6) Present Form in Training & Competition
- 7) Performance Under Pressure in Open Championships
- 8) COPS & Specto
- 9) Personal Discipline

### 5.2 The following information will be provided to support the selection of athletes:

- a) Coaches' overall assessment
- b) Results in Local / Overseas Competitions:
  - Women's & Men's Team
    - i. Singapore Nationals (May/June 2021)
    - ii. National Programme Roll-Offs (dates to be confirmed)
    - iii. Thailand Open – 24 to 27 Aug 2021 (subject to it being held and permission to travel and participate being granted).
- c) Training attendance
- d) Sports Medicine and Sports Science services update

## **6. Final Selection**

### 6.1 Athlete must fulfil the requirements in clause 4 and will be selected based on selection criteria stated in clause 5.

- 6.2 Athletes shall be required to be certified medically fit to compete at the SEAG by qualified SSI personnel prior to nomination to the SNOC and shall remain medically fit to compete to be eligible to compete in the SEAG.
- 6.3 If a nominated athlete fails to fulfil the requirements stated in clause 4 and/or because of injury/illness is unable to represent Singapore at the SEAG, the selection panel, at its own discretion, reserves the sole right to replace the nominated athlete with another athlete. Replacement athletes must also fulfil the requirements in clause 4.
