

# 51ST SINGAPORE NATIONALS & 6TH NATIONAL YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS 2021 27 NOVEMBER - 11 DECEMBER 2021



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Q1. Is this tournament really happening?

The status of the tournament will be updated in the week of 15 - 19 November, pending the Government's SMM guidelines nearer to date.

### Q2. Can I take part in Multiple Divisions?

Yes you can take part in any number of divisions as long as you can meet the respective criteria.

### Q3. I'm below 12 years old and Not Vaccinated, am I required to obtain Pre-Event Testing?

Pre-Event Testing (PET) is exempted for all children under the age of 12 (Born 2009 and after) so you will not need to go for testing. However, please stay home or see a doctor if you are unwell.

### Q4. I'm Not Vaccinated, can I participate in the tournament?

Yes you can! However, you will be required to obtain Pre-Event Testing that is valid for the day of attendance. This test will be at your own cost and must be obtained from an Authorised Medical Provider.

### Q5. I'm Not Vaccinated, do I need to obtain PET if I were to go to the bowling centre for practice?

The bowling centre is located inside Temasek Club and Temasek Club only allows entry for fully vaccinated individuals. Exemption if the individual has a valid negative PET certificate issued by MOH, or if they are aged 12 years and below.

### Q6. How much is the Masters Final Fees?

For this tournament, there's no additional Masters Fees Required.

### Q7. How to register and what is the payment mode?

Fill up the Google Form (link on our website) and submit to us before 18 November 2021, 2359hrs. Payment will be via PayNow QR only and we will provide the QR code at a later date.

### Q8. Can my friends come to support me?

Due to capacity restrictions, no spectators are allowed for this tournament. Only 1 registered Coach may tag their participating bowler on the day of their registered squad. Children under the age of 15 years old who are not under any Academy and does not have any Coach, may have 1 Adult Companion above the age of 18 to be with them.

### Q9. I received a Health Risk Warning (HRW). May I still participate?

You received a Health Risk Warning (HRW) SMS as you are a close contact to a COVID-19 case, or living with someone who is under Home Recovery. Should you need to leave your home over the next 7 days, you will need to take an ART self-test and test negative before you leave.

### Q10. A member of my household tested positive on the Antigen Rapid Test (ART). May I still participate?

While you may not be issued a Health Risk Warning (HRW) if a member of your household tests positive on an Antigen Rapid Test (ART), it is still advised that you take the following precautions:

1. Minimise contact with the household member.
2. Take an Antigen Rapid Test (ART) self-test and only leave your home if you test negative on your ART self-test.

### Q11. I am tested positive for Covid-19 (on ART self-test / ART / PCR) and will not be able to attend the tournament. What should I do?

### Q12. I'm in the midst of bowling and received a Health Risk Warning (HRW) SMS. What should I do?

You will have to stop bowling immediately. Inform the organiser that you have received a HRW and leave the premise to self-isolate. You are legally required to self-isolate immediately and take an ART self-test at your residence within 24 hours.
