# Selection for the 31<sup>st</sup> SEA Games

## 1. The Event

The 31st<sup>th</sup> SEA Games (SEAG) will be held from 12 to 23 May 2022 in Hanoi, Vietnam.

1.1 The events which will be contested in the SEAG have been confirmed by the SEAG 2021 Organizing Committee as follow:

# 2. Selection Panel

- 2.1 Singapore Bowling Federation (SBF)'s National Coaching Staff will evaluate and recommend the athletes to SBF's Selection Sub-Committee for endorsement.
- 2.2 The Selection Sub-Committee comprises of:
  - a) Dr Valerie Teo (Chairman)
  - b) Mr Tan Zhi Qiang
  - c) Mr Lionel Lim
  - d) Mr Mike Lam
- 2.3 The recommended athletes will then be submitted to SBF's General Council for approval for nomination to SNOC to represent Singapore at the SEAG.

#### 3. Appeals

- 3.1 The Appeals Sub-Committee is available to look into disputes relating to the selection or non-selection of an athlete.
- 3.2 The Appeals Sub-Committee comprises of:
  - a) Mr William Wong (Chairman)
  - b) Mr William Chua
  - c) Ms Ong She-na
- 3.3 In the event where a bowler disagrees with the results of the team selection, the bowler must write into the Appeals Sub-Committee strictly within seven (7) days after an official team announcement is made/ informed to the players via email. Appeals made after the seven (7) will not be entertained.

#### 4. General Eligibility

- 4.1 To be eligible for nomination, each athlete must:
  - (a) Be a citizen of the Republic of Singapore (Athletes must be Singapore Citizens and should not be holding dual citizenship if they are above 21 years old at the time of nomination.)
  - (b) Agree and sign the SBF's Code of Conduct/Bowler Agreement
  - (c) Be able to commit to a regular training program outlined by the coaches at the beginning of the year

# 5. Selection Criteria

- 5.1 SBF's Six (6) Selection Criteria:
  - 1) Performance Under Pressure
  - 2) Team First Attitude
  - 3) Present Form
  - 4) Technical Skills (Variation)
  - 5) Spare Percentage (Single Pins & Makeable Spares)
  - 6) Personal Discipline
- 5.2 The following information will be provided to support the selection of athletes:
  - a) Coaches' overall assessment
  - b) SEA Games Roll-Offs (Feb 2022)
  - c) Training attendance
  - d) Sports Medicine and Sports Science services update

#### 6. Final Selection

- 6.1 Athletes must fulfil the requirements in clause 4 and be selected based on the selection criteria stated in clause 5. The SEA Games selection roll-offs will take place from 12 February to 27 February 2022.
- 6.2 Athletes shall be required to be certified medically fit to compete at the SEAG by qualified SSI personnel prior to nomination to the SNOC and shall remain medically fit to compete to be eligible to compete in the SEAG.
- 6.3 If a nominated athlete fails to fulfil the requirements stated in clause 4 and/or because of injury/illness is unable to represent Singapore at the SEAG, the selection panel, at its discretion, reserves the sole right to replace the nominated athlete with another athlete. Replacement athletes must also fulfil the requirements in clause 4 and selection criteria in clause 5.

## 7. SNOC Selection Criteria

- 7.1 Athletes who have currently achieved at least 3rd placing e.g., time/distance/score/mark of the 2019 SEA Games. For team sports, they should currently be ranked 3rd among the SEA Games countries. Athletes/Teams who miss the qualifying standard marginally but show potential to equal or surpass it in time for the Games.
- 7.2 Pursuant to the Olympic Charter (By laws to Rules 27 and 28, paragraph 2.1), "Selection shall be based not only on the sports performance of an athlete, but also on his ability to serve as an example to the sporting youth of his country."
- 7.3 In addition to the above selection criteria, the following "qualities" of the athletes will be taken into consideration:
  - Attitude and behavior towards coaches, teammates, fellow athletes, officials, and sports administrators, whether in relation to sporting matters or otherwise.
  - General conduct and character which may affect the reputation, image, values or best interests of the athlete or the sport.
  - Past disciplinary record.
  - Current skill level and fitness; and character
  - Level of commitment and attendance.
  - Potential for future development.
  - Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials; and
  - Such other non-performance related qualities as the selectors may consider to be relevant.
