FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

TOURNAMENT RELATED QUESTIONS

Q1 How much is the Registration Fees & Masters Final Fees?

Registration Fee is \$280/team. Masters Final Fees is \$70/bowler.

Q2 How to register and what is the payment mode?

Fill up the Google Form (link on our website) and submit to us before 6 March 2022, 2359hrs.
Payment will be via PayNow QR only and we will provide the QR code at a later date.

Q3 Can my friends come to support me?

Due to capacity restrictions, no spectators are allowed for this tournament. Only 1 registered Coach may tag their participating bowler on the day of their registered squad. Those participating in the Under 12 & Under 16 divisions who are not under any Academy and does not have any Coach, may have 1 Adult Companion above the age of 18 to be with them.

Should there be any changes to the capacity restrictions (subject to SportSG's Advisory), we will announce again.

Q4 Can I join the tournament as an individual?

The tournament is in the All Events format, consisting of Singles, Doubles & Team Event. Hence, individual participation is not applicable. You will need to form a minimum of 2 bowlers in the team, in order to register for the tournament.

Q5 Can I team consist of both Boys & Girls?

No. All team members in the team must be of the same gender.

COVID/SMM RELATED QUESTIONS

Q1. I'm under 12 years old and Unvaccinated. Can I join this tournament?

Yes you can! However, as we are still uncertain of the SMM guidelines for U12 Division at this point, given that the Division will consist of both unvaccinated & Fully Vaccinated individuals, you may only indicate your choice of squads in order of preference and we will allocated base on first-come, first-served, after the SportSG Advisory is published, on the guidelines and treatment for this age group.

Q2 I have completed my Primary Vaccination series but yet to take my Booster shot. Can I join this tournament?

The Booster shot is required within 270days from the last dose of your primary vaccination series, in order to maintain your "Fully Vaccinated" status.

An individual is considered Fully Vaccinated for 270days after the last dose of their primary vaccination series (if they did not take their booster shot yet). Should the individual lapse the 270days and yet to get their booster shot, their Trace Together (TT) app Vaccination status will turn grey and show "Additional dose needed", then the individual will not be considered as Fully Vaccinated, and will not be allowed to enter venues with Vaccination Differentiated SMM (VDS) in place. This is already in effect for those age 18 & above (since 14 Feb), and will take effect from 14 March for those age 12-17.

If you have yet to take your booster shot, please ensure that your vaccination status remains valid throughout the whole tournament period in order to enter the venue (i.e Your last dose of your primary series should not be before 25 July 2021, in order to be still within 270days as of 20 March 2022). You should also be able to see in your TT App, the date that your primary dose is valid till, and ensure that it covers the tournament period.

Should your status change halfway through the tournament period, you will then not be allowed to enter the venue or participate in the tournament and no exceptions will be made.

Q3 I'm under 12 years old and Unvaccinated. I was tested Positive via self-test ART and have since recovered. Can I join this tournament?

Based on the latest Advisory, there is no restriction on VDS for Under 12 individuals. However, your vaccination status recorded for the tournament will be based on the following:

Unvaccinated and recovered from Covid-Positive / ART-Positive:

1. have received a Discharge/Recovery Memo - Fully Vaccinated (for 180days from the day your 1st positive test was recorded)
2. did not receive a Discharge/Recovery Memo - Unvaccinated.

*Based on the latest news on 23 Feb 2022, if your Covid-Positive/ART-Positive is recorded in HealthHub via any combined test centre or Quick Test Centre through a supervised self-administered ART, there will not be a recovery memo issued.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q4 I'm above 12 years old and unvaccinated, can I participate in the tournament if I obtain a Pre-Event Test (PET)?

As both the Bowling Centre & Temasek Club have VDS in place, you will not be allowed to enter the venue, UNLESS you have a Discharge/Recovery Memo from being tested Covid Positive before, within the last 180days (valid till 20 March 2022)

From 1 January 2022, the concession for unvaccinated individuals to perform PET in lieu of being fully vaccinated will be removed. Only fully vaccinated, recovered, or medically ineligible individuals, or children aged 12 years and below (subject to venue/event specific caps) will be allowed to enter settings where VDS is implemented. **Fully recovered individuals will need to produce valid Discharge/Recovery Memo as proof for entry.**

Q5 Do I need to obtain PET for the tournament?

An attendee/patron is exempted from PET if he or she:

- Has been fully vaccinated (as per TT App status) or
- Has recovered from COVID-19 i.e. less than 180 days of first positive Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test result obtained in Singapore; or
- Has a negative result on a pre-event test (PET) by an MOH-approved COVID-19 Test Provider in the past 24 hours, covering the duration of the stipulated activity.
- Is a child aged 12 years and below.

Q6 I received a Health Risk Notice (HRN). May I still participate?

You received a Health Risk Notice (HRN) SMS as you are a close contact to a COVID-19 case, or living with someone who is a Covid case. Should you need to leave your home over the next 5 days, you will need to take an ART self-test and test negative before you leave your house.

Q7 A member of my household tested positive on the Antigen Rapid Test (ART). May I still participate?

While you may not be issued a Health Risk Notice (HRN) if a member of your household tests positive on an Antigen Rapid Test (ART), it is still advised that you take the following precautions:

1. Minimise contact with the household member.
2. Take an Antigen Rapid Test (ART) self-test and only leave your home if you test negative on your ART self-test.

Q8 I am tested positive for Covid-19 (on ART self-test / ART / PCR) and will not be able to attend the tournament. What should I do?

Q9 I'm in the midst of bowling and received a Health Risk Notice (HRN) SMS. What should I do?

You will have to stop bowling immediately. Inform the organiser that you have received a HRN and leave the premise to self-isolate. You are required to self-isolate immediately and take an ART self-test. You can continue with normal activities for the day if the test result is negative.
